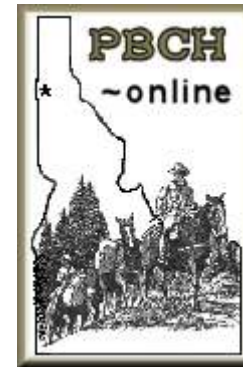

**It has been hot! It is a bit more challenging to find a cool place to horseback ride but oh it's so worth it.**

**Many of my friends have been riding 4<sup>th</sup> of July Pass on a regular basis. It is off limits to motorized traffic, easy to get to off I-90 and lots of trailer parking. Much of the riding is in the big stands of Doug fir and cedar trees up there and the ground is not rocky or uneven. You do need to pack water for your animals.**

**Another popular place has been Anton Peak over in Washington, not far from Dr. Peters' vet practice. Logging roads and some steady climbing offer a good workout with good trailer parking.**

**Another place deep in the woods is off Twete Road up Bernard Peak. It has a great lookout over Lake Pend Oreille and Farragut Park. There are many trails in there for many hours of riding.**

**Blue Creek Rec. Area is close to town right off I-90. It is easy to get to and offers some climb to it and great views of Lake Coeur d'Alene. The Yellowstone Road can be quite dusty right now but the parking is good. Pack water for your animals. The trails are well-marked and wide and safe on this BLM managed land.**
