Amended and Adopted February 18, 2017

SECTION 1101 – STATE MEETINGS

- #1 Standing Rule: That the dues for the Panhandle Back Country Horsemen shall be \$40.00 \$40.00 for a family membership, \$30.00 for an individual membership, \$30.00 for a youth group membership.
- #2 Standing Rule: A sponsorship for a member is \$10 per year. A non-member can become a sponsor for \$30 per year. This includes your business card in the monthly newsletter.
- #3 Standing Rule: That Chapter meeting will be held at the Dalton City Hall unless otherwise stated in the minutes of a preceding meeting.
- #4 Standing Rule: That Panhandle Back Country Horsemen members required to travel for Chapter business shall be reimbursed for expenses as follows: Transportation by air, actual round trip cost using the least expensive fare and route; by auto \$.32 cents per mile round trip from the travelers home to the meeting site.
- #5 Standing Rule: Lodging should be at actual cost not to exceed \$100 per night.
- #6 Standing Rule: Meals, with the exception of the Convention , will be allowed at, \$40.00 per day maximum. Convention cost is to be paid to Board of Directors and Foundation Director to attend.
- #7 Standing Rule: The treasurer shall, no later than December 31 of each calendar year remit to the Back Country Horsemen of Idaho (BCHI) the BCHI portion of dues collected during that calendar year.
- #8 Standing Rule; That members may be reimbursed by PBCH for one way vehicle transportation to work projects at the rate of \$0.50 per mile from their home to the project site.
